

Submission for the Dutch Student Research Conference 2019 open access journal

1. Terms of Submission

By submitting a document, the submitting authors agree that:

- They have authored the document;
- They have complied with the consent requirements (section 2);
- They have complied with the authorship requirements (section 3);
- They have complied with publication requirements (section 4);
- They have complied with the code of conduct (section 5);
- They agree with the copyright statements (section 6)

2. Consent

2.1 Responsibility for consent

It is the responsibility of the submitting author to fulfill the consent requirements

2.2 Consent requirements

This section is only applicable when the submission is experimental (medical) research

All experimental subjects must have consented to participate in the research, and have consented for their anonymised details to be published

All patients must have consented to participate in their medical treatment, and have consented for their anonymised details to be published

Consent for participation, and publication of anonymised details must be in writing

Copies of consent for participation and publication of anonymised details must be made available at the request of the editorial team

3. Authorship

3.1 Authorship requirements

It is the responsibility of the submitting author to guarantee the authorship of the submission

It is the responsibility of the submitting author to obtain the agreement of the other authors for submission of the document to the SRC

It is the responsibility of the submitting author to provide evidence of this agreement when requested by the SRC

4. Publication

4.1 Responsibility for publication requirements

The submitting author accepts full responsibility for fulfilling the publication requirements

The submitting author agrees to contact the SRCas soon as the non-fulfillment of the publication requirements is discovered

In so far as the relevant material is an image or graphic, published under the creative commons license, it is not considered to be a 'component of the document'

4.2 Publication requirements

This must be the first submission of the document, or any component of the document, with a view to publication

The document, or any component of the document, must not be published elsewhere
The document, or any component of the document, must not be under consideration for publication elsewhere

The document, or any component of the document, will not be submitted with a view to publication elsewhere

5. Disclosure

5.1 Responsibility for disclosure

The submitting author accepts full responsibility for fulfilling the disclosure requirements

5.2 Disclosure requirements

5.2.1 Accuracy of disclosure

The disclosure requirements must be accurate

Evidence of the accuracy of the disclosure requirements must be provided to the SRC when requested

5.2.2 Substantive requirements

The following information must be provided with each submission to the SRC

Institutional, commercial, industrial, governmental and charitable affiliations of any authors which might be perceived as potential sources of bias

Financial, managerial, academic, professional relationships of any of the authors which might be perceived as a potential source of bias

Sources of funding to any of the authors which might be perceived as a potential source of Bias

6. Ethical considerations

6.1 Responsibility for fulfilling ethical requirements

The submitting author accepts full responsibility for fulfilling the ethical requirements mentioned in this document.

6.2 Ethical requirements

For the purposes of this section, institutional guidelines refers to the protocols specified by the facility (or persons responsible for the facility) at which the research was conducted

For the purposes of this section 'research' includes, but is not restricted to,

- randomised control trials
- case control and cohort studies
- observational studies
- literature reviews

Conduct of the research was in accordance with institutional guidelines

7 Copyright

7.1 Author's rights

The authors of the submission retain the copyright on the submission

The authors of the submission are granted the right to have their submission attributed to them when their submission is published by the SRC

The right of attribution is only granted to those authors named at the time of submission

The authors of the submission are granted the right to refuse alterations to the content of their submission after their submission has been published

7.2 Editorial rights

The SRC journal reserves the right to refuse publication of submissions

The submitting author agrees to grant an exclusive and continuing license to the SRC to publish the submission online and in print, under the creative commons attribution license (CC BY SA)

The submitting author agrees to fair modification of the formatting of their submission by the SRC at any time, and without notice

The SRC reserves the right to withdraw any submission in total (but not in part) from publication once published at any time, and without notice
